# Rachel's Reflections

When I joined Greenwood Women Care four summers ago, I never imagined I'd one day be writing this message as Chair of the Advisory Board, let alone as the first to follow in the footsteps of our organization's founder.

Back then, I was a northerner newly relocated to Greenwood, completely unfamiliar with giving collectives. My introduction to GWC happened in 2020 when I was invited to represent the Emerald

City Rotary Foundation in the annual check presentation photo. Even though we were masked for the photo, I could feel the warmth and connection among the women of GWC. I was also struck by the range of nonprofit organizations being recognized that day, and my curiosity was officially sparked.

In February 2021, I attended my first Quarterly Meeting as a guest (via Zoom thank you, Covid). Later that summer, I joined the in-person August Quarterly Meeting at Cokesbury College. While a storm raged outside, we enjoyed a video celebrating the previous year's grantees, and I left completely inspired.

That following winter, I attended the New Members Soup Supper, where I was met with the kindest hospitality and some of the best soups, rolls, salad and dessert I have ever been treated to. There, I learned about the committees that keep this organization thriving. I jumped in with Communications, joined the Advisory Board, served as Vice Chair, and now... here I am!

The deeper I became involved, the more I appreciated what GWC has accomplished in such a brief time. Since our first granting cycle in 2019, we've awarded \$403,974 to local nonprofits, and after this year, we'll be closing in on the half-million-dollar mark.



## It will soon be time for.....

## YOUR VOICE. YOUR VOTE. YOUR IMPACT.

One of GWC's most important moments – the chance for YOU to help decide which local nonprofits will receive our grants. Your vote makes a difference.

### HOW VOTING WORKS

Members will rank all project proposals in order of preference. Points are assigned from your rankings and grants are awarded based on total points received.

#### RESOURCES TO SUPPORT YOUR VOTE

In late September, you will receive project summaries by email with details on:

- The need each project addresses
- The nonprofit's plan and expected outcomes
- Costs and plans to measure success

Each summary will include an evaluation tool to help you score proposals on factors like clarity, feasibility, potential to improve services and fulfill unmet needs, likelihood of lasting change, and whether the cost matches the project. Tallying your scores can make ranking easier.

#### PREPARING TO VOTE

In early October, you will get a mailed packet with a ballot worksheet and voting instructions. Use the worksheet to record your rankings ahead of time. When voting opens, you'll receive an email link to the online ballot.

- Look for your mailed worksheet and instructions (late Sept/early Oct)!
- Join us at the Kick-Off-The-Vote meeting on Monday, October 20 for fun, fellowship, inspiration, and insight into this year's proposals!




